

Stay Alert for Fraud Awareness this Holiday Season

BE AWARE OF THESE COMMON UTILITY SCAMS



Disconnection Deception Scammers call threatening disconnection of your utility service, demanding immediate payment by prepaid cards.



Power Restoration Charge Scammers call offering to

restore power more quickly for a fee in the aftermath of severe storms causing widespread power outages.



Overpayment Tactic Scammers call claiming you have overpaid your utility bill, and you need to provide personal bank account information or a credit card number to facilitate a refund.



Identification Attack The scammers direct the caller to press 1 to collect more data in an effort to get personally identifiable information.



Number Spoofing

Scammers will spoof a callback number that closely resembles the utility's number.



Door Knocking Impostor Door-to-door impostors

pose as utility workers to gain entry or access into unsuspecting victims' homes.
